## The Squirrel Glider- Faith

### Cool Stats:

Have you ever heard of the squirrel glider? The squirrel glider's body is 8 inches long. But its tail is 10 inches long. Squirrel gliders can glide for a distance of up to 164 feet. A full-grown squirrel glider weights only a little over 6 ounces.

### Fun Facts:

Other names for the squirrel glider are flying squirrel or sugar squirrel.

Squirrel gliders eat fruit, insects and the sap from eucalyptus trees.

### Animal Connection:

The squirrel glider is not a squirrel at all. It actually is a member of the opossum family. When it senses danger, it jumps and moves in the direction of the thickest growth of trees around, trusting that there will be branches to grab onto for safe landing!

### Fruit of the Spirit Connection:

Sometimes trusting God can be like taking a flying leap! Second Corinthians 5:7 tells us we live by faith. That means that when we obey God, we can trust Him to be there. We may not be sure how God will take care of us, but even when we feel afraid, God always keeps His promises! He'll "catch" us by guiding us and helping us. God will always take care of us.
