In 1867, Alfred Nobel discovered a way to encase highly volatile nitroglycerin into a form that was safer and more convenient to handle. He patented this new invention as dynamite, and during his lifetime it made him millions of dollars.

One morning, Nobel opened a newspaper and found that his own obituary had been printed there by mistake. What disturbed Nobel more than the papers' error was the words that he read: “The merchant of death is dead....Dr. Alfred Nobel, who became rich by finding ways to kill more people faster than ever before, died yesterday.”

Alfred considered all of his worldly success to be nothing if it meant that he would be remembered in such a way. So, on November 17, 1895, Nobel signed his last will and testament and set aside the bulk of his estate to establish a fund that would reward certain individuals whose work was deemed to be beneficial to society. This award is known today as the Nobel Prize.
